Our Inter House Athletics Carnival is a great day for the four Houses to battle it out on various track and field events.

Each student has been placed in one of the four Houses, North (Red), South (Blue), East (Green) or West (Orange) and is permitted to get dressed up in their House colours at this carnival, however clothing must be suitable for participation in sports events.

Medallions will be awarded to the student who scores the most points in individual events (Age Champion) at each age group and a shield is presented to the winning House.

Students are encouraged to participate in at least 3 events (these events may include field events, track events) or students must nominate to help staff who are officiating events throughout the day. We are trying to encourage all our students to support their House in any way possible.

All students will need to wear a hat at all times unless competing in events. Sun-screen will be available, but students are encouraged to bring their own. Water will be provided and students will need to bring their own drink bottle to refill. Students will also need to provide their own lunch, however there is also canteen available for food and drink purchases throughout the day.

Students who would like to represent the school in athletics at the South Australian Christian Schools Association Carnival (SACSA) in Week 10 and at the Schools Sports South Australian Carnival (SSSA) in Week 11 will need to make sure they participate on the day in their chosen events.

After Care Group, students will walk to SA Athletics Stadium with staff, and are required to remain onsite at the stadium for the day. Students will be dismissed from the stadium at the conclusion of the carnival at approximately 2:30pm. The School buses will collect students from the venue at the conclusion of the carnival. There will also be a number of staff who will be walking back to school at the conclusion of the carnival.
