The annual Interhouse Swimming Carnival is back to being at the start of the year and will be held on Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> February, Week 1, Term 1.

Our Interhouse Swimming Carnival is a great day for each house to battle it out in different swimming and novelty events. Students have really enjoyed the day in the past as a fantastic opportunity for community spirit and fun to start the school year.

Each of the students in the school has been placed in one of the four houses; North (Red), South (Blue), East (Green) or West (Orange). Students are strongly encouraged to participate in at least one event. A shield will be presented to the winning house and medals will be awarded to the student who scores the most points in each age group.

Students will need to come to school on the Friday in either correct school sports uniform or may dress up in their house colours. All students will need to wear a hat and t-shirt at all times unless competing in events. Sunscreen will be available but students are encouraged to bring their own. The canteen will be open at the pool. Cordial and water will be provided.

Students will be transported to the pool by train (no ticket required) and they will be dismissed from the Unley Swimming Centre at 2.15pm where they can get picked up by a parent/guardian or catch a train/bus back to school or whatever is organised. Students will need their own ticket for this trip. The Northern and Southern school buses will pick students up from the pool at 2:15pm.

Students who achieve competitive times across the day will be presented the opportunity to represent Temple Christian College at SSSA and SACSA Swimming Carnivals later in the term.
