Good afternoon families,

Thank you for your support for the school and the school community during this time of uncertainty.

We are looking to partner with families over the coming months to engage all students with an opportunity to learn online, and keep students connected to the school community while working from home.

Last week of Term 1

In response to the Prime Minister's announcements on Sunday 29th March, Temple Christian College will be transitioning to online learning from Monday 30th March.

Throughout Week 10 (Monday 30 March to Friday 3 April) staff will have notes on SEQTA for all of their classes, enabling all students to be able to access work from home. Students who are onsite will also access online notes in SEQTA, however this may not be in their usual classroom with their usual teacher.

An important change in notification for students attending school – Parents will now need to notify the Student Services Office (SSO) by 8am each day that the student will be physically present at school. This will need to take place each and every day that the student attends the school campus to enable our administration team to account for all attendances.

Important preparation for online learning

It is important that all students prepare for online learning and we encourage all students to complete the following actions by **Wednesday 1st April 2020**:

- Collect required Textbooks and reading novels from the SSO
- Collect personal medication from the SSO
- Take all required books home from their lockers
- Download Team Viewer and Zoom apps on laptops from Software centre (must be completed onsite).

The Team Viewer software has been installed to enable our ICT team to assist students who may be experiencing any tech issues whilst participating in online learning.
