Good afternoon families,

Thank you for your faithful support for the school community as we continue to navigate the uncertainties surrounding the COVID-19 restrictions and education.

Having successfully embarked on the Online Learning Journey at the start of Term 2, I would now like to inform you on a number of decisions that we have been able to make as a leadership team with regards to the return to in class face to face teaching.

As the situation in South Australia continues to improve, we are now confidently working towards the return to in class face to face teaching for the start of Week 4.

In preparation for a smooth transition, we will be implementing the following staggered approach:

Commencing Week 2 - Monday 4th May

Introducing some Year 12 classes onsite

- Some Year 12 classes will begin to occur onsite as from the start of Week 2.
- This will mainly impact students who are participating in subjects with a significant practical component.
- Students from within these classes will be notified by their teacher(s) and given all the relevant details.
- These classes are not compulsory however they will be beneficial.
- Students attending these classes are expected to be presented in their full Winter School Uniform and will need to sign in and out of the school premises as normal.

Commencing Week 3 – Monday 11th May

All teaching staff to teach the Online Learning program from school

- From the start of Week 3, all teaching staff will return to the school campus to deliver their Online Lesson from their regular teaching space.
- All students will continue to engage with the Online Learning Program either from home or onsite during this week.
- Students that are onsite will be able to return to their subject teaching space for their Online Lesson.
- These students onsite will be supervised by their subject teacher as they work through the Online Lesson material.
- Students at the school during this week will be expected to be organised with headphones or earphones as teachers will still conduct Zoom calls during all lesson for week 3.
- Students onsite will have the opportunity to ask additional questions and interact with their subject teacher during set class times.



Commencing Week 4 - Monday 18th May

All students to return to face to face in class teaching

- As from Monday 18th May, in class face to face lessons will commence as the regular Temple Christian College timetable (as outlined in the School Planner) will be re-introduced.
- All students will be expected to return to regular school attendance commencing each day at 8.30am to 3pm.
- Students will be required to wear their full Winter School Uniform during Term 2.
- The Online Learning Program will no longer be active as all students will be expected to engage with their learning onsite.
- From this point forward, teachers will no longer be connecting directly with students that are offsite during lesson times.
- We anticipate that the skills that have been learnt by students and staff during the Online Learning program time will enable any student to be able to continue with their learning if they need to be offsite.

Thank you again for your patience as we outwork this transition back to a more normal school program and look forward to keeping you up to date as the term progresses.
