



SA Health Regulations regarding COVID-19

Dear School Community,

I'm just sending a reminder of the SA Health regulations around COVID Close Contacts.

If a member of your household tests positive to COVID, then all household members must isolate for 14 days. If the COVID positive person can fully isolate from the rest of the household, then the isolation period is reduced to 7 days, however we would expect that most families would need to undertake the 14 days of isolation.

The COVID positive person is required to isolate for 10 days.

Classroom Contacts are not required to isolate but should monitor for symptoms. If our case numbers do increase, then a particular class could be deemed as an 'outbreak', and all members of that class may be required to get a PCR test. We will let you know if this happens, and what you would be required to do. This has not yet been necessary on our school site.

As always, please don't send your child to school if they are unwell. Please be understanding if your child becomes unwell at school and you are called to come and take them home.

If your child is unwell, please encourage them to rest and recover. If they are just isolating and are not sick, they are able to access as much of the curriculum as possible, and Mrs Sarah Wolf has sent some information to help the students do this successfully.

Thank you for your cooperation and support through this difficult time.
